Every Employee is encouraged to identify hazards and report any unsafe or potentially unsafe work practice or work place (even where there is doubt), to relevant safety committee personnel and to immediately raise the matter with his or her immediate manager if the employee believes it is not being addressed in an appropriate and timely manner.

This policy will be implemented and maintained by:

- Embracing the principles of OHS risk management
- Adopting a consultative and cooperative approach with all parties
- Operating an effective workplace OHS network
- Implementing OHS training and the dissemination of OHS information
- Implementing timely and cost effective rehabilitation of injured employees
